Dear Parents and Carers,

What a wet start to the new term! I am certain it saves up the rain for the beginning and end of the school day! If it is heavy rain our children do not go outside to play, instead they have an indoor playtime where they have the opportunity to play a board game with their friends or draw, colour, play Lego etc. If you do have any old games at home, which have all the pieces, we would be very grateful for these for wet lunchtimes!

Several of our children took part in the final race of the **cross country league** on Wednesday afternoon. I am delighted with both the results and the attitudes of all of our children, every child gave their best, trying their hardest, supporting others and represented the school very well. Overall our school came 6th in the whole league, out of the 30 schools who took part. A super result. Our girls team came in 6th place in the girls league and our boys came in 4th place. Our year 4 girls came in 5th place out of the year 4 girls and the boys came in 4th position. For year 5, the girls came in 5th place and the boys were placed 3rd! Our year 6 girls came in 10th position overall and our year 6 boys in 7th. I think you will all agree these are super results for all of our children. Within the top ten finishers were: Mia Jones 4th, Jessica Campbell-Carr 6th, Elliott Shepherd 7th, Oscar Hyland 8th and Jacob Williams 9th. We are also so proud of both Kairo and Mikel Sage for their final finishing positions. Out of the whole league, Mikel came in 2nd place out of 58 runners. He only ended up in 2nd place as he could not run in the final race due a small fracture on his leg last week! If he had entered he would have been placed 1st, a great achievement! Kairo was 1st in his age group having won every race in the league for his age—an outstanding result from Kairo! Well done to all our children who represented the school so well.

Just a reminder next week we will be celebrating **WORLD BOOK DAY** with a variety of activities during the week. The children may come into school dressed in an outfit from a character in a story on **WEDNESDAY 6th MARCH!** If your child does not wish to dress up as a character from a book, they may come into school in their own clothes instead. We really do not mind what they wear on this day, as long as they come into school and join in with the fun! **Hurstwood, Kemsley and Oakwood classes will be visiting Wigmore library, but NOT** during this week, all children have had a letter with the date of their library visit on. Mrs Fifield has also organised a Chocolate Bar Competition, with the lucky winners of the 5 golden tickets winning a book related prize. 
**Monday:** Children to bring in a book of their choice to share

**Please note the date change for Sports Day which we had to change from the Thursday to the Wednesday due to the clash with the Mini Youth Games**




